
> Australia has the third highest rate of pet ownership in the world (63%)

> Australia has an ageing population







PETS IN AGED CARE SNAPSHOT

- 18% FACILITIES CONSIDER ALLOWING RESIDENTS TO KEEP A PET.
- 22% RESIDENTIAL FACILITIES ALLOW FAMILY AND FRIENDS TO BRING PETS FOR A VISIT.
- 33% RESIDENTIAL FACILITIES HAVE SHARED PETS.
- 24% RESIDENTIAL FACILITIES OFFER A VISITING PETS PROGRAM.
- 9% IN-HOME CARE PROVIDERS OFFER A PET-FRIENDLY SERVICE.



OTHER FINDINGS OF THE SNAPSHOT

7% OF PET SURRENDERS ARE ELDERLY-RELATED.

SURRENDER REASONS INCLUDE

- > OWNER HEALTH OR DEATH.
- > UNSUITABLE PET ACCOMMODATION AT HOME.
- > FAMILY UNABLE/UNWILLING TO CARE FOR PET.
- > LACK OF FINANCIAL MEANS.


WHY SERVICE PROVIDERS CAN'T BE PET-FRIENDLY

- > INABILITY TO FUND PROGRAMS.
- > LACK OF SUPPORTIVE EMPLOYEES/VOLUNTEERS.
- > WORKPLACE HEALTH & SAFETY ISSUES.
- > FINANCIAL OR LEGAL CONCERNS.




How to be pet-friendly
